

# Create a desktop shortcut to update the RadioSure station database.

Download this archive on the Github repository :

Extract db-update.vbs in the RadioSure folder

**RB2RS-Database-Updater**

This VBS Script download and install the latest "unofficial" list of radio stations for RadioSure.

This list of stations is a conversion (made by Francois-neosurf) of the "Radio-Browser.info" database.

Place this script in the RadioSure folder, then you can launch it with a ".bat, a shortcut or the task scheduler :

**Extract its contents into the RadioSure folder.** (Where the "RadioSure.exe" file is located.)

**Right-click on the "db-update.vbs" file in the RadioSure folder, then click on "Send to" and choose "Desktop (create shortcut)".**

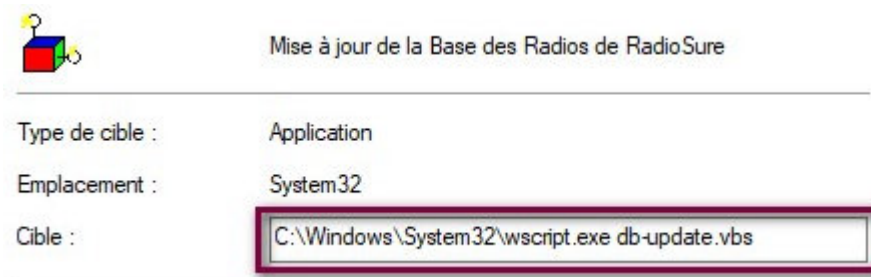

On the desktop, **right-click on the new shortcut**, then choose '**Rename**' to give it a name (e.g. : "RadioSure Database Update") then validate.



**Right-click again on the shortcut**, then choose "**Properties**".

In the "**Target**" box, put : **wscript.exe db-update.vbs**



Good to know : You can get a better rendering by clicking on "**Change icon**" and choosing the main icon of "**RadioSure.exe**" (e.g.) into the RadioSure folder.

**You can now validate by clicking on OK.**
